PARKING PERMIT BUY BACK PROGRAM

If you don't regularly use your car, turn in your parking permit for a \$50 bonus.

Construction is expected to start in Winter Quarter on the new Parking Structure 1 (PS1) project. Portions of Lot 13 will be closed for construction over a 12-month period beginning with a full closure of the eastern half of Lot 13 in late January or February. Effects of the closure will be felt campus wide as <u>all</u> parking lots will be heavily impacted in order to make room for those losing their current lot.

If you currently have a residential parking permit and find that you aren't using your car, you can turn it in for a one-time \$50 incentive plus you save money by no longer paying for a parking permit. You will also receive a refund for any un-used portion of the permit.

Official rules:

- The Program is available to undergrads that currently hold a residential parking permit at Glen Mor, Pentland Hills, Lothian or A&I.
- The student would be required to return their current parking permit for a minimum period of three months. A refund would be provided for any unused portion. They would not be eligible to purchase another parking permit until their three month obligation has been met.
- The resident can choose from a one-time \$50 payment paid via a credit to their Student Banner Account or a \$50 Dining Gift Card.
- If/when the student decides to re-purchase a parking permit, they would be allowed to obtain a permit for the same lot they had already been assigned to.
