## Parking

---

Parking for Commencement ceremonies is complimentary, and parking permits are not required. General parking is available in **Lot 13** and **Lot 30**, where you can park in any unmarked, unreserved space. Lots are no more than a five- or ten-minute walk to Pierce Lawn, where all ceremonies will be held. Please do not park in reserved, service, or disabled spaces without an appropriate permit.

Be aware that traffic around campus will be congested, so plan on arriving **90 minutes before the start of the ceremony**. Please follow the directional signage to the designated parking lots; from there, you will be directed to the best available parking.

## Disabled Parking/ Mobility Assistance Shuttle

---

Lot 6 has been reserved for guests with a disabled plate or placard, and guests who require mobility assistance. Once parked, please check in at the Shuttle Waiting Zone where parking staff will assist you. The Shuttle will take you directly to the east-side of the entrance of the commencement venue where you can meet the rest of your family and friends. From there, Lot 6 is less than a 10-minute walk to Pierce Lawn. Shuttles will transport guests back to Lot 6 after the ceremony. Please note that shuttle service is limited to the disabled/mobility impaired and one family member.

## Driving Directions

Please note: Directions based on online maps may route drivers along narrow campus roads. Please follow the directions below:

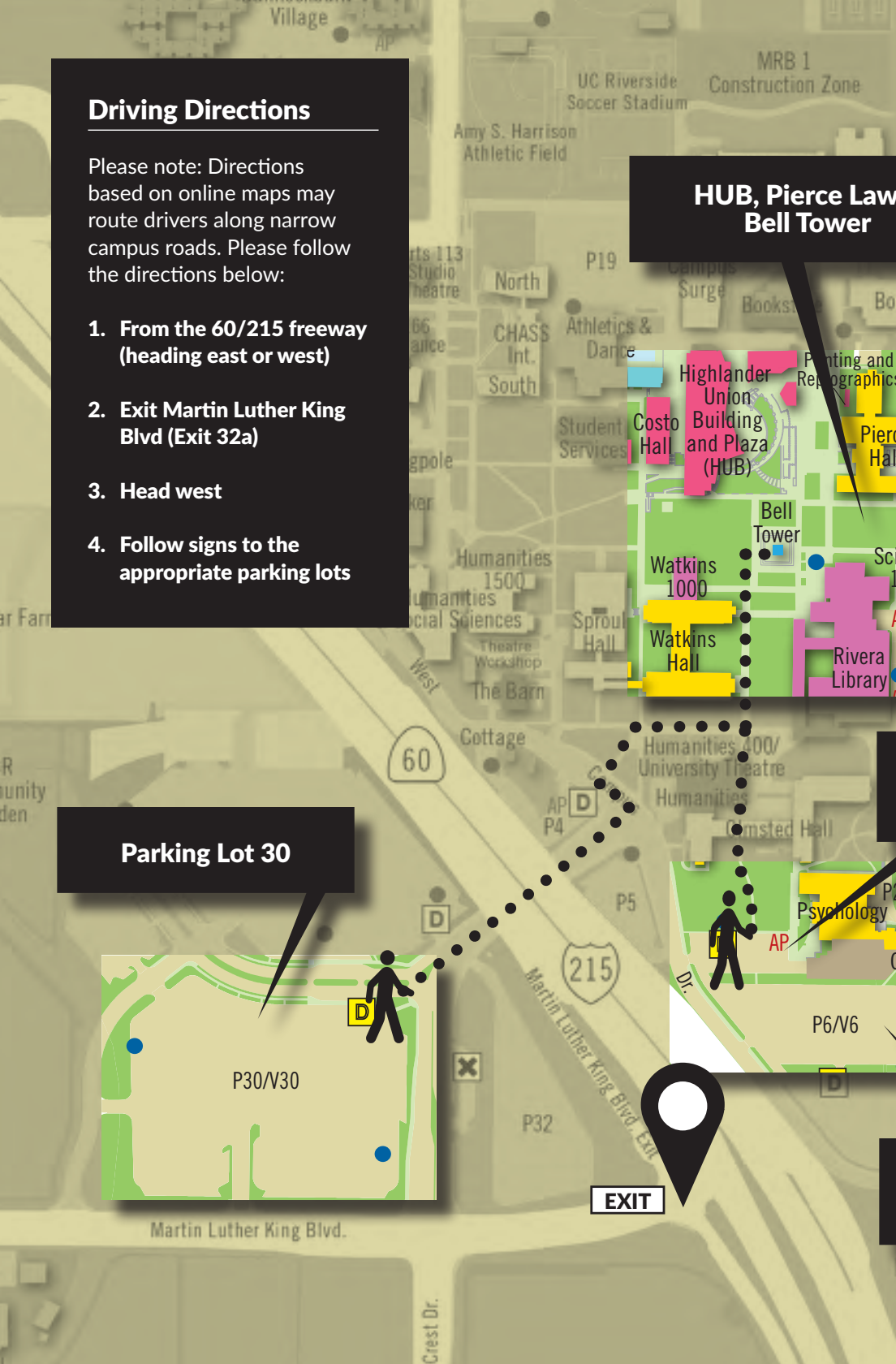
1. From the 60/215 freeway (heading east or west)

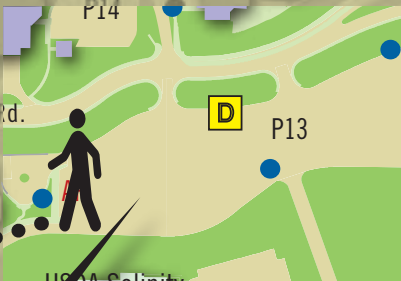
